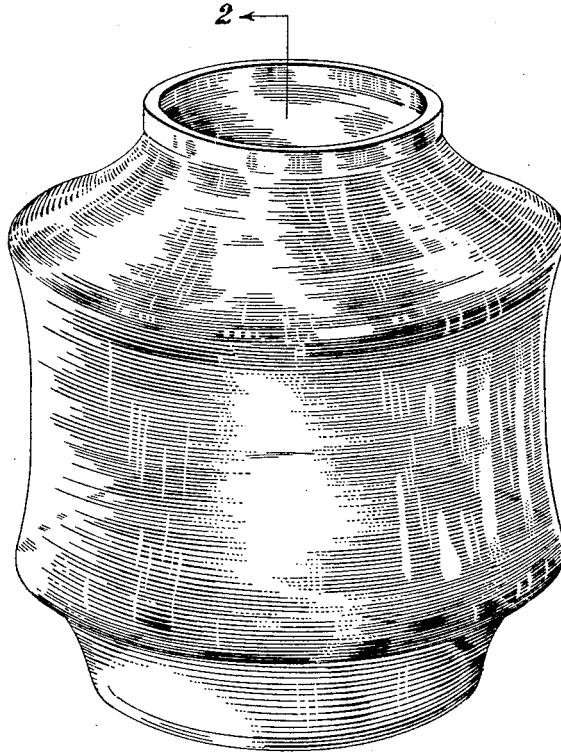

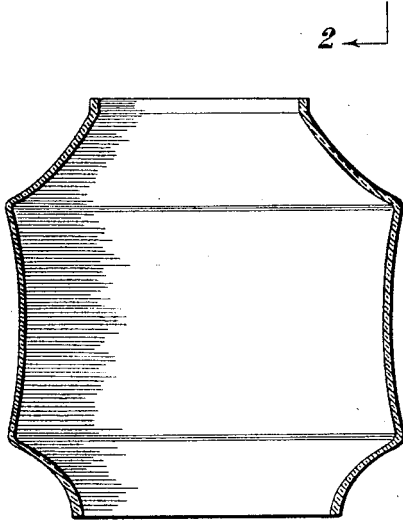

DESIGN FOR A GLOBE FOR VENDING AND DISPENSING DEVICES

Application filed January 2, 1931. Serial No. 38,187. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRANK H. VOGEL, a citizen of the United States, residing at Columbus, in the county of Franklin and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Globe for Vending and Dispensing Devices, of which the following is the specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of the globe for vending and dispensing devices, showing my new design. Figure 2 is a cross-section taken on the lines 2—2 of Figure 1.
