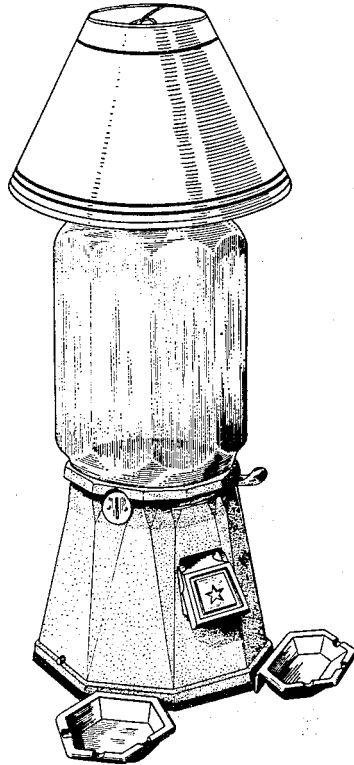

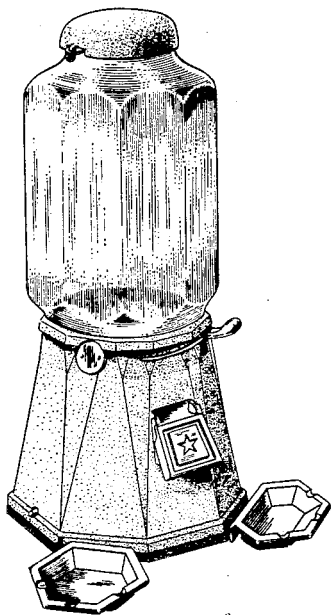

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, RALPH A. VOGEL, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Columbus, in the county of Franklin and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Vending Machine and Lamp or Article of Similar Nature, of which the following is the specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.
