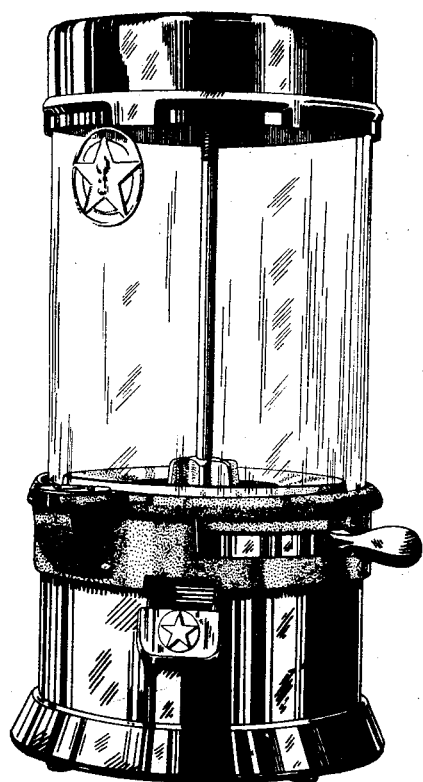

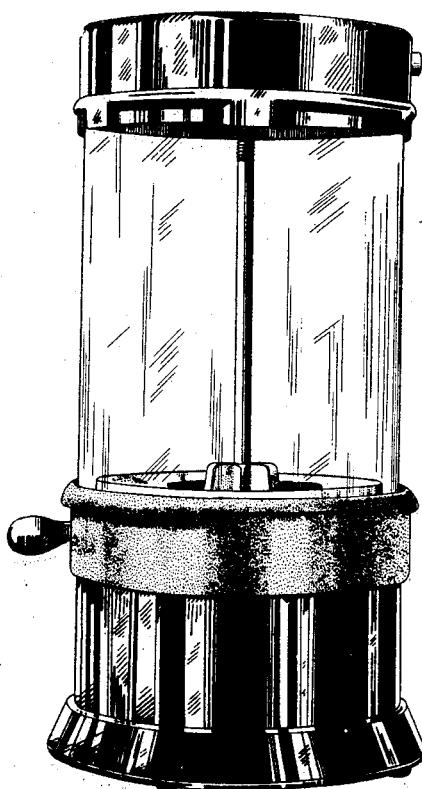

DESIGN FOR A VENDING-MACHINE CASING

Application filed March 3, 1930. Serial No. 34,717. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRANK H. VOGEL, a citizen of the United States of America, and a resident of Columbus, in the county of Franklin and the State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Vending-Machine Casing, of which the following is the specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part hereof.

Figure 1 is a front perspective view of the vending machine casing showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a rear perspective view taken diametrically opposite to Figure 1.
